

A train always has advantage

Consider the situation

Consider the situation. Adjust your speed, stop at the level crossing and, if you are a driver, do not overtake other vehicles.

The railway is not a playground

Never walk, run or ride a bicycle on the railway. Also, it is forbidden to pass under the composition, between the cars, or to climb on the train that stopped.



Always expect a train

They can move on any track, at any time, or in any direction. Keep in mind that more tracks means more trains that can be nearby.

It's faster than it seems

The train always has the right of way and for train it is difficult to stop. Trains can be closer to you and move faster than they seem at first glance.

Observe traffic signals

Traffic participants are obliged to respect traffic signals. Before stepping on the track, stop the vehicle and stop if you are a pedestrian or cyclist.

Cross the track correctly and safely

If the ramps are lowered and the light signs indicate that crossing is prohibited, stop. Take care of visibility, road conditions and the load you are carrying.

Act responsibly

The largest number of accidents at road crossings occurs due to negligence, non-compliance with regulations, as well as due to inappropriate behavior of traffic participants.

Please wait! Look to your left and to your right

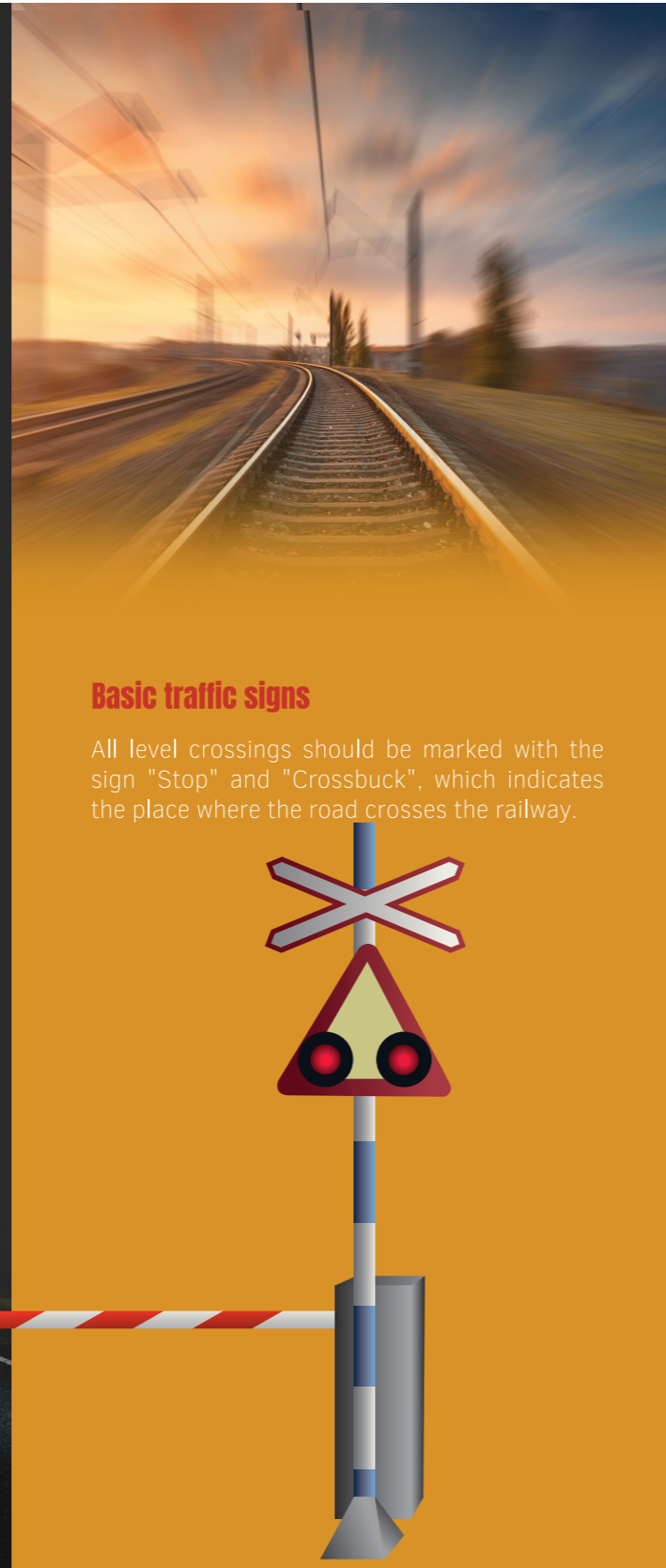
The crossing of pedestrians, cyclists and motor vehicles over railways can create a whole range of risks and dangers. Unfortunately, most road users cross the railway incorrectly, sometimes without stopping.

Be responsible

Stop before the level crossing, look to your left and right, check that the level is free, and when you are sure that you cannot see or hear the train in the distance, cross the line.

Do not break the regulations!

Irresponsible traffic participants cross the railway at unmarked crossings, bypass ramps, ignore signals or use mobile phones while driving. By doing so, they violate legal regulations and contribute to accidents that can have a deadly outcome.



Basic traffic signs

All level crossings should be marked with the sign "Stop" and "Crossbuck", which indicates the place where the road crosses the railway.



The train can come from any direction.



The train cannot be stopped instantly.



Follow and obey traffic signs.



The width of the train is greater than the width of the track itself.



Do not stop at a level crossing.



Be aware of size and weight.



Avoid uncontrolled crossings

Traffic participants are prohibited from crossing the railway at unauthorized and unmarked crossings.

Always be careful

If you come across a damaged or broken ramp, or crossings that is not properly marked, be extra careful.

If you are in a vehicle...

If you are in a vehicle, turn off the music and open the window to hear if a train is coming. Driving on the track and in the area around the railway is strictly forbidden.
