Domain/Target: Young drivers

YEARS is an all-encompassing 3-years project that aims to offer a better understanding of young drivers as a road user group particularly at risk and to address this risk through innovative actions.

The project will look at the current situation in the MS and will present latest data on road deaths involving young people, the main risks they face and what can be done to address these.

Good practice and effective measures adopted by MS will be promoted and disseminated through national conferences in order to raise awareness along stakeholders, spur on national administrations to take action, share best practice and reduce the number of young people killed on the roads.

In addition, YEARS will also mobilise university students to run a RS project that will improve the safety of VRUs in their community. Students will develop their ideas in a Brussels camp. The best 3 projects will be awarded and presented in a Brussels Conference.

- 15 universities lectures
- Student Challenge with one week training camp + award conference
