

SAFE ROADS IN THE EU **Vulnerable Road Users**

GROUPS MOST AT RISK FOR ROAD TRAFFIC FATALITIES

BY MEANS OF TRANSPORT

CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS

Number of fatalities does not decrease as quickly as others over time.

POWERED **VO-WHEELER** RIDERS

High share of fatalities when compared to the number of vehicles and vehicle-kilometres.

BY AGE

YOUNG PEOPLE (18-24 YEARS)

- 8% of the total population, but 14% of fatalities.
- In 2017, two thirds of the young people killed were drivers.
- Young men have the highest risk rate.

ELDERLY PEOPLE

- Share of elderly road victims increasing in line with their population share.
- In 2017, 26% of those killed were 65 years or older.
- Most often injured and killed when walking or cycling inside urban areas.
